Progress

The project outlined in the 2013 plan (see website for details) has progressed well. Building work is expected to finish at the end of February 2014.

Some very generous residents have made significant donations to ensure that the Trustees have sufficient funds to finance all planning and building costs including VAT.

Finishing Off

The Trustees are now making an APPEAL to all residents for funds to finish off the project to a standard of which we all can be proud—and one which will attract increased and enhanced usage of the facility.

Funds are sought to finance (approximate figures):-

Kitchen fittings	£10,000
Flooring Improvements	£5,000
Redecoration	£5,000
Total	£20,000

A raffle is being planned but the main source must be donations (which qualify for gift aid and therefore benefit from a 25% government “subsidy”).

All donations, however small, will be welcome to finish off this project which is central to our village. We are hoping to have the official “Opening” in April 2014.
