The Village Hall's new Trustees have considered 3 options for the re-development of the Hall and unanimously voted to pursue a redevelopment plan originally designed for the Hall by local architect Scott Dyer. These plans were drawn up in conjunction with members of the previous Trustees committee and address some of the key requirements for the Hall including provision of disabled toilets and an updated kitchen facility.

Basingstoke & Dean Borough Council have previously granted Planning Permission to these plans so no statutory objections are anticipated. The plans can be seen on the development project page and at Basingstoke & Dean Council's planning website, application number: [BDB/66895](#)

The Finance and Re-development sub-committees will progress this option in more detail, including obtaining competitive tenders, gaining re-approval of planning permissions and developing a fundraising plan for the project.

Once the Trustees have a more detailed scope of work for the complete project, including all costs, villagers will be invited to discuss/review the plans fully at a special meeting of the village.
